Mission: We deliver Exceptional Early Childhood Education and Develop compassionate Partnerships with Families to support them in realizing their Hopes and Dreams

- We serve families whose income is at or below 100% of the Federal Government Poverty Guidelines. Families are categorically eligible for services if they are receiving public assistance (SNAP/TANF/SSI), are in foster/kinship care, or are experiencing homelessness.

- Our early childhood education and comprehensive program serves families within three counties: Clark, Madison and Montgomery including our partnership childcare programs.

- Program Options include:
 - Early Head Start classroom experience for infants/toddlers (6weeks-3yrs old)
 - Parents/Guardians must be working/school.

 - Head Start classroom experience for children ages 3yrs-5 years of age.
 - Full-Day session: up to 10 hours, Monday-Friday. Parents must be working or in school, and must apply for ODJFS childcare benefits, pay a co-pay for extended services.
 - School Day-6-hour session Monday-Friday, usually 9-3pm. Limited slots at various locations at no cost.
 - Part-Day (half-day) sessions, Monday-Thursday:
 - either morning 8:00a-11:30 am or afternoon 1:00pm--4:30pm at no cost.

 - Early Head Start/Home Base program—Home Base visitors provide educational activities and comprehensive services for an hour and half, one time per week in the home and monthly socialization opportunities.
