

United Way of Clark, Champaign & Madison Counties has been entrusted by donors to allocate funds raised through the Springfield Unity Fund and was established to provide targeted services to Springfield nonprofits supporting our immigrant neighbors. The following guidelines and safeguards are in place in place to ensure these emergency funds are disseminated with urgency.

Guidelines for Distribution of the Springfield Unity Fund

1. Funding requests must be made by a 501(c)3, governmental agency, educational institution or an organization that is under a financial sponsorship of a 501(c)3.
2. Funding requests must be received in writing through the Springfield Unity Fund application.
3. Organizations may request funding for projects up to \$7,500. Fund requests must include financial rationale for the amount requested. Additional funds may be requested in Phase 2 as funds become available.
4. Requests for funding will be presented to the United Way of Clark, Champaign & Madison Counties Impact Committee and approved by the UWCCMC Executive Committee.
5. Organizations receiving funding must give recognition to United Way of Clark, Champaign & Madison Counties and when applicable utilize our logo.
6. Organizations will be required to provide reporting to United Way of Clark, Champaign & Madison Counties as to how the funding was utilized.
